**Post A – Student Photographer**

- (i) Responsibilities: Capture highlights of the camp and help edit photos for publicity and promotion.
- (ii) Requirements: HKU current students who are passionate in photography; have relevant photo editing skills (such as Photoshop); possess photo-taking experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).
- (iii) Benefits and Rewards:  
Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student photographer will be entitled to:
  - a. Honorarium of \$500 for each full day;
  - b. Editing of photos for final output after the camp: \$500;
  - c. A certificate; and

**Post B – Student Videographer**

- (i) Responsibilities: Capture the highlights of the camp, conduct interviews with participants and create a viral video for publicity.
- (ii) Requirements: HKU current students who are passionate in video shooting and production; have relevant video production and editing skills; possess video-taking

experience in large-scale events and have own video cameras for use are preferred (or provided by CEDARS).

(iii) Benefits and Rewards

Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student hosts will be entitled to:

- a. Honorarium of \$500 for each full day;
- b. Production of video of the camp: \$1,000;
- c. A certificate; and
- d. [CEDARS reward points](#).

**Post C – Event Assistant**

(i) Responsibilities: To assist in preparation of materials, venue set-up, registration, crowd control, usher, and provide support to on-site logistics.

(ii) Requirements: HKU current students; self-motivated, responsible and proactive; good team players with good communication and interpersonal skills; previous experience in supporting large-scale HKU events are preferred.

(iii) Benefits and Rewards

Upon satisfactory performance and attendance, student hosts will be entitled to:

- a. Honorarium of \$500 for each full day;
