

MTR Student Travel Scheme 2012/2013

To: All Full-Time Students

Full-time students who have not yet reached 26 years of age may apply for the MTR Student Travel Scheme (an applicant's age is determined by the time when the application is submitted).

"Full-time course" means a course which normally requires the participant to attend an acceptable institution to receive not less than 20 hours of academic instruction each week for 30 weeks or more in an academic year (including incoming exchange/visiting students with at least one semester of full-time study at HKU and HKU regular students on exchange to non-local partner institutions).

Application Form can be obtained from Faculty Offices, CEDARS, HKUSU and Halls.

Students should go to their respective offices as listed in the below for verification of student status and submit the endorsed application forms to any MTR Customer Service Centre (except Airport Express stations, Lo Wu, Lok Ma Chau, Racecourse, Disneyland Resort and Sunny Bay stations) from 1 September 2012 onwards.
