Next Steps & Support Options

1. Off-campus Housing

CEDARS offers resources, including:

Explore verified student housing options with HKU CEDARS support, including transparent information and direct referrals to trusted accommodation providers. More new student-specific housing options will be added over the next two months—please check regularly for updates.

You are strongly encouraged to confirm your housing for next academic year asap, as availability in the market is limited and you will be competing with other new students for the same supply.

4. **Appeal Process**

You may submit an appeal to the Hall/College within 72 hours of the result announcement via the HKU Portal if you have exceptional circumstances (e.g., medical conditions, financial hardship). Please include supporting documents to justify the housing needs.

Instruction on Appeal for UNSUCCESSFUL Applicants: Unsuccessful applicants who wish to appeal against the decision of halls should submit their appeals through the [Hostel Management System](#) within 72 hours immediately following the announcement of the results (i.e. 16:00 on August 20, 2026).
