Those efforts have enabled us to connect with students from all over the world regardless of whether they are in HK or not.

We are looking forward to meeting students on campus in the coming fall. To facilitate ongoing interaction and development of deeper layers of engagement among local and non-local students, a Global Friends Programme (GFP) will be launched for the academic year of 2021-22.

The GFP aims to engage both local and non-local students in organizing and participating in programmes over time with the support from CEDARS. Students are asked to serve as partners and leaders under the GFP. At the end of the programme, participants are expected to develop:

- (1) a mindful reflection of intercultural experience and competence;
- (2) commitment to and recognition of the mutual benefits of such interaction/ engagement,
- (3) a sense of belonging of HKUers, contributing, and being valued.

GFP Ambassadors will be required to attend briefing and/or training sessions. A training session will be held in late July or Aug 2021. Briefing sessions will be held around the beginning of each semester.

Requirements:

HKU current local students with fluent spoken English; friendly, outgoing and sociable with commendable communication and engagement skills in eliciting students' active participation in the event are preferred; strongly interested in inter-cultural interaction; active, creative, skillful in making short video clips and graphic design; and have overseas experience and/or experience in working with people from diverse cultural background is preferred.
