HKU current students or fresh graduates with a good command of spoken and written English and/or Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua); friendly and sociable with commendable communication and interpersonal skills; familiar with the HKU campus and the local communities nearby; creative and skillful in graphic design; and have overseas experience and/or experience in working with people from diverse cultural background.

Experience as Master of Ceremony, Weeks of Welcome (WoW) tour guides, student hosts, student ambassadors or buddy mentors will be a bonus.

Job Duties:

To assist in the organisation and implementation of a series of fun-filled orientation programmes (WoW tours, Orientation Day, Buddy Scheme, etc.) for new non-local students within and outside the campus; lead a group of student hosts for the Orientation Day and WoW tours; provide administrative support and assistance in designing publicity materials; perform other ad hoc duties as assigned; be able to work on weekends and in the late evenings sometimes.
