- (3) Artificial Intelligence Literacy Courses:
Students must complete 6 credits in artificial intelligence literacy. They should take one 3-credit course in Year 1 and another 3-credit course in Year 2. (See Regulation UG5(e)).
- (4) Common Core Courses:
 - (i) Students are required to take 36 credits in the Common Core Curriculum. They should take four Common Core courses in year 1 and two in year 2. They should select not more than one course from the same Area of Inquiry (AoI) within one academic year and at least one and not more than two courses from each AoI during the whole period of study.
 - (ii) Students should also check whether or not they have met the pre-requisites requirements, and whether written approval is required from the offering department. Please ensure that necessary approval is obtained duly, if required, and that there is no timetable clash before enrolling in these courses.
