1. The Prayer Room operates from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily (except Chinese New Year Holidays). Users are expected to adhere to these operating hours and promptly vacate the area at closing time.
2. The Prayer Room is open for use by all HKU students of different religious belief. Seating is available on a first-come-first-served basis. Users are encouraged to dress modestly and appropriately while inside the Prayer Room,
3. Please do not leave your personal belongings unattended. The staff of the Amenities Centre reserve the right to remove any unattended items. The University will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal property.
4. All furniture should be used in their designated positions, and they should not be moved without permission from the Amenities Centre.
5. To ensure a clean and tidy environment, it is essential for users to consistently maintain cleanliness in the area and furniture.
6. Users are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and peaceful manner while inside the Prayer Room. Any disruptive behavior or actions that disturb other users will not be tolerated.
7. Please refrain from eating and drinking in the room.
8. Users are encouraged to report any issues with the facilities to the Amenities Centre staff for prompt assistance.
9. The Centre reserves the right to modify or update these rules as necessary to ensure the smooth operation and safety of the Prayer Room. By adhering to these rules, users can contribute to a positive and respectful environment within the Prayer Room.
