# HKU Class of '84 Social Inclusion Fund Inclusion Leadership Award for Exchange Programme Application Guideline

## A. Objective

The Award is supported by the HKU Class of 84 Inclusion Fund<sup>1</sup> which was set up by the Class 84 in 2009 to celebrate the silver jubilee of their graduation. The Award aims to recognize and award students who have made outstanding contribution to social inclusion activities in Hong Kong.

#### B. Award

- 1. The Award will only be granted in respect of **non-local attachment programme** administered by the HKU authority that will **last for one semester or one academic year**.
- 2. The maximum amount of grant for exchange programme in Mainland is **HK\$15,000** and for exchange programme in places other than Mainland is **HK\$30,000**. The award amount depends on the merit of the applicant.

### C. Eligibility

Applicants must have, in the 5 years preceding the Award, made an outstanding contribution to social inclusion activities in Hong Kong and been conducive to the promotion of harmony amongst members of the public in Hong Kong who are divided into sectors on the basis of **ethnic origin, race, cultural origin, gender or religion**.

#### D. Assessment Criteria

- 1. Applications will be assessed on the basis of the followings:
  - (i) the leadership displayed in the relevant social inclusion activities;
  - (ii) the level of commitment (factors include, but are not limited to, the role played, involvement and the time committed);
  - (iii) the impact of the applicant's participation; and
  - (iv) the impact of the relevant activities.
- 2. Successful applicants of 'Social Inclusion Activities Grants of HKU Class of '84 Social Inclusion Fund' merit preferential consideration.
- 3. Applicants may be invited for an interview by the Steering Committee.
