

## Henry Chan Inclusive Education Award Application Guideline

### 1. Objective

To recognize the excellent academic or extra-curricular performances of students with a disability\* in the University of Hong Kong.

### 2. Eligibility

2.1 Local full-time HKU students with a disability\* (including attention deficit/hyperactive disorders, autism/autistic spectrum disorders, hearing impairments, mental illnesses, physical handicap, specific learning disabilities (e.g. dyslexia), speech impairment, visceral disabilities or visual impairments) are eligible to apply.

2.2 Applicants must also have:

- (a) An accumulative GPA of 3.0 or above (or equivalent); **or**
- (b) Actively participated in student activities, such as taking up official positions in student groups/societies or representing the University in external events and competitions, in the past academic year.

### 3. Award

Five annual awards of HK\$10,000 each will be disbursed, but the Steering Committee may decide to give more than five awards.

### 4. Application Procedure

Applicants should submit the following documents to the Counselling and Person Enrichment Section, Centre of Development and Resources for Students (CEDARS) via email at [cedars-accessibility@hku.hk](mailto:cedars-accessibility@hku.hk):

- (a) The completed [application form](#);
- (b) A copy of the most recent medical report which indicates the current level of disability;
- (c) A CV; and
- (d) Proof of academic achievement and/or records of extra-curricular activities.
